The OIG requests authority to advertise vacancies, then advertises the vacancy in People First. The OIG conducts interviews and completes hiring package for submission to HR. The agency head reviews the hiring package, approves the hire and sets (with OIG recommendation) a salary consistent with the salary of others in the same or similar positions in the department. Once a start date is established, the agency head, chief of staff or assistant secretary signs the hire offer letter. The OIG provides this letter to the prospective hire.
